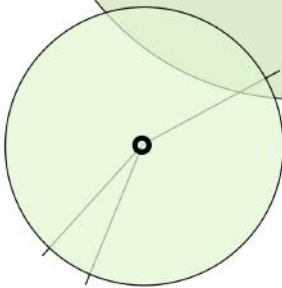

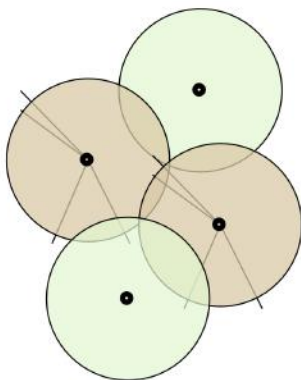
CONIFEROUS TREE ADD-ON

60MM STARTING AT \$550/EACH

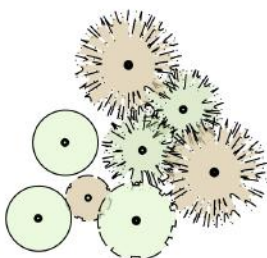


POTTED TREE ADD-ON

Trembling Aspen <i>Populus tremuloides</i>	Great tree for moist soil, with beautiful leaves. Green foliage turns yellow in the fall.	Zone 2-3' full sun to part shade, prefers moist soil, ht. 10m, sp. 5m	\$
Prairie Spire Green Ash <i>Fraxinus pennsylvanica 'Rugby'</i>	A dense tree with a strong central leader. Hardy tree, great for shade	Zone 2b, full sun, tolerant to varying soil conditions, ht. 15m, sp. 8m	\$
Swedish Columnar Aspen <i>Populus tremenda 'Erecta'</i>	Beloved for its narrow form, it's commonly used in tight areas for privacy.	Zone 2-3, sun/shade, prefers moist soil, ht. 12m, sp. 2m	\$
Princess Kay Plum <i>Prunus nigra 'Princess Kay'</i>	Compact ornamental tree, with profuse white flowers in spring. produces no fruit.	Zone 2b, full sun, requires well drained soil, ht. 5m, sp. 3m	\$
Dakota Pinnacle Birch <i>Betula platyphylla 'Fargo'</i>	Its dense and narrow upright form makes it ideal for small spaces. Smooth white bark.	Zone 3b, sun/part shade, prefers moist well drained soil. ht. 8m, sp. 3m	\$
Schubert Chokecherry <i>Prunus virginiana 'Schubert'</i>	Well known for its deep purple summer and fall leaves, it's fruit is ornamental.	Zone 2, full sun, well drained soil, ht. 9m, sp. 4m	\$
Klondike Amur Cherry <i>Prunus Maackii 'Jefdike'</i>	Small oval form tree, with brownish red bark. Attracts birds.	Zone 2, full sun, well drained soil, ht. 8m, sp. 5m.	\$\$
'Snowbird' Hawthorn <i>Crataegus x mordenensis</i>	Compact, well formed tree, with excellent flowers and leaves. Great for small yards.	Zone 3, full sun, well drained soil, ht. 6m, sp. 3m	\$\$
Crab 'Pink Spire' <i>Malus x adstringens</i>	Lavender-pink flowers, narrow-short form, with profuse flowering.	Zone 2-3, full sun, well drained soil, ht. 3-6m, sp. 2-4m	\$\$
Spring Snow Fl. Crab <i>Malus 'Spring Snow'</i>	This hardy and well formed crabapple produces an array of white flowers in spring.	Zone 3a, full sun, well drained soil, ht. 7m, sp. 4m	\$\$
Bakeri Spruce <i>Picea pungens 'Bakeri'</i>	Vibrant silvery blue colour remains year round. Very hardy spruce variety.	Zone 2a, full sun, tolerates moist or dry soil, ht. 10m, sp. 4m.	\$\$
Amur Maple <i>Acer ginnala</i>	Classic tree, with vibrant red fall colours	Zone 3, full sun, well drained soil, ht. 5m, sp. 3m	\$\$\$
Japanese Tree Lilac 'Ivory Silk' <i>Syringa reticulata 'Ivory Silk'</i>	This small, oval shaped tree has green foliage, and flowers in late spring.	Zone 3, full sun to part shade, well drained soil, ht. 5m, sp. 3m	\$\$\$
'Columnar Blue' Blue Spruce <i>Picea Pungens</i>	Narrow shape makes this cultivar ideal for smaller yards.	Zone 2, full sun, well drained soil, ht. 6m, sp. 2m	\$\$\$
Swiss Stone Pine <i>Pinus cembra</i>	Compact columnar growth pattern with great form. slow growing and low maintenance	Zone 3a, full sun, well drained soil, ht. 10m, sp. 5m	\$\$\$

Common Lilac <i>Syringa</i>	Fragrant, and flowers in spring.	Zone 2, full sun, well drained soil, ht. 3m, sp. 2m
Dwarf Korean Lilac <i>Syringa Meyers 'Palabin'</i>	Lavender flowers, ideal for small spaces or hedge.	Zone 2-3, full sun, well drained soil, ht. 1.25m, sp. 1.5m
Ivory Halo Dogwood <i>Cornus alba 'Bailhalo'</i>	Full and compact form make this a great choice. It's colours of green and cream white leaves are unique.	Zone 3, sun or partial shade, well drained soil, ht. 1.5m, sp. 1.5m
Darts Gold Ninebark <i>Physocarpus opulifolius 'Dart's Gold'</i>	It's yellow leaves show all season, and is a very hardy shrub. Great for hedges or mass planting	Zone 2, full sun or part shade, prefers, well drained soil, ht. 1.5m, sp. 1.5m
Little Devil Ninebark <i>Physocarpus opulifolius 'Donna May' (FE)</i>	Similar in form to the Darts Gold, this ninebark however is burgundy. It's hardy, and keeps a low-growing compact form.	Zone 3, full sun or part shade, prefers, well drained soil, ht. 1.5m, sp. 1.5m
Abbotswood Potentilla <i>Potentilla fruticosa 'Abbotswood'</i>	This mounded shrub produces small white flowers all summer long. It's hardy, and requires little maintenance	Zone 2, full sun or part shade, prefers, well drained soil, ht. 1m, sp. 1m
Goldflame Spirea <i>Spiraea bumalda 'Goldflame'</i>	Low growing compact shrub with green foliage with red tips. Masses of pink flowers throughout the summer.	Zone 3, full sun or part shade, prefers, well drained soil, ht. 1.5m, sp. 1.5m
Golden Currant <i>Ribes aureum</i>	Compact growth, black berries used for edible fruit or ornament.	Zone 2, full sun, prefers well drained soil, ht. 1.5m, sp. 1.5m
Nanking Cherry <i>Prunus tomentosa</i>	Light pink flowers, small red cherries which are edible.	Zone 2, full sun, well drained soil, ht. 2m, sp. 2m
Cotoneaster <i>Cotoneaster lucidus (acutifolius)</i>	Well known as 'Hedge Cotoneaster' this shrub is hardy, dense, and prunes well.	Zone 2a, full sun to part shade, well drained soil. ht. 2.5m, sp. 2m
Arctic Willow <i>Salix purpurea 'Nana'</i>	Compact, bluish green foliage, great for swales, and moist soil.	Zone 2-3, sun or partial shade, prefer moist soil, ht. 1m, sp. 1m
Concorde Barberry <i>Berberis thunbergii 'Concorde'</i>	Visually stunning purple/red leaves. Very compact and slow growing. Great for Xeriscaping.	Zone 3, full sun, prefer dry well drained soil, ht. 0.6m, sp. 0.5m
Tundra Honeyberry <i>Lonicera caerulea 'Tundra'</i>	Honeyberry or 'Haskap' are edible berries grown on this hardy and compact shrub. <b>*needs another variety of honeyberry to pollinate.</b>	Zone 2, full sun, prefer well drained soil, ht. 1.5m, sp. 1.5m
Berry Blue Honeyberry <i>Lonicera caerulea 'Berry Blue'</i>	Honeyberry or 'Haskap' are edible berries grown on this hardy and compact shrub. <b>*needs another variety of honeyberry to pollinate</b>	Zone 2, full sun, prefer well drained soil, ht. 1.5m, sp. 1.5m
Parkland Series Rose 'Morden Fireglow' <i>Rosa Parkland 'Morden Fireglow'</i>	Double flowering, deep red, cross between native plants and lightly scented flowers. Reblooms on new growth, but may require some pruning.	Zone 2a, sun or partial shade, prefer moist well drained soil, ht. 0.6m, sp. 0.5m
Dwarf Mugo Pine <i>Pinus mugo var. pumilio</i>	Hardy shrub, good for foundation planting.	Zone 1-2, sun or partial shade, well drained soil, ht. 1m, sp. 1.5m.
'Prince of Wales' Juniper <i>Juniperus horizontalis</i>	Low lying evergreen, great for ground cover, and winter foliage.	Zone 2, full sun, well drained soil, ht. 0.2m, sp. 2m
Blue Arrow Juniper <i>Juniperus virginiana 'Blue Arrow'</i>	A hardy evergreen, that is excellent for border planting, privacy, and adding height to a landscape. It's blue colour remains year-round.	Zone 3, sun or partial shade, prefers dry soil, ht. 6m, sp. 1.5m
Dwarf Globe Cedar <i>Thuja occidentalis</i>	A well formed and round shrub. May need winter protection to stay healthy.	Zone 3, sun or partial shade, prefers moist soil, ht. 1m, sp. 0.75m

Dwarf Norway Spruce <i>Picea abies 'Pumila'</i>	A dwarf compact/dense evergreen. Low maintenance shrub.	Zone 3a, sun or partial shade, prefers well drained soil, ht. 1m, sp. 1m

Alpine Currant <i>Ribes alpinum</i>	Dense shrub, great for hedges or mass planting. Hardy and adaptable	Zone 2, sun/shade, suitable in various soil conditions, ht. 2m, sp. 1.5m
Snowbelle Mock Orange <i>Philadelphus 'Snowbelle'</i>	White flowering, hardy shrub, native to southern Alberta, sweetly scented.	Zone 3, sun/shade, suitable in various soil conditions, ht. 1.5m, sp. 1m
Annabelle Hydrangea <i>Hydrangea arborescens 'Annabelle'</i>	Distinctive ornamental ball-shaped flowers make this an eyecatcher. It's compact, and performs well in moist soil	Zone 3, prefer shade, prefer moist soil, ht. 0.5m, sp. 0.5m
Dwarf Winged Burning Bush <i>Euonymus alatus compacta (PW)</i>	With vibrant red fall colour, this compact low-lying shrubs makes an excellent accent piece	Zone 4, sun/shade, suitable in various soil conditions, ht. 1.5m, sp. 1m
False Spirea <i>Sorbaria sorbifolia</i>	Profuse growing, hardy shrub, that is suitable in most soil conditions. It can be invasive, and should be used in larger spaces.	Zone 2, sun/shade, suitable in most soil conditions, ht. 2m, sp. 2m
Dogwood 'Red Osier' <i>Cornus sericea, C. Stolonifera</i>	Great year round shrub, vivid red bark in winter, green foliage in summer, very hardy, and prefer shade.	Zone 2-3, prefer shade, prefer moist soil, ht. 2m, sp. 2m

Common Name <i>Latin/Scientific</i>	Details	Specifications
Francee Hosta <i>'Hosta' Francee</i>	Shade loving, hardy perennial with large green leaves and white trimming. lavender purple flowers sprout mid summer.	Zone 2a, part shade - full shade, prefers moist soil, ht. 18" sp. 30"
Periwinkle <i>Vinca minor</i>	This low-lying spreading plant makes great groundcover. It's lavender coloured flowers are attractive, and this dense growing perennial does well in the sun or full shade.	3a, sun or shade, prefers moist soil. ht. 4", sp. 30"
May Night Meadow Sage <i>Salvia nemorosa 'May Night'</i>	Large purple flowered spikes spring up from adaptive species. It's flowers bloom late in the spring, but last until late summer, giving it wonderful visual interest. Good en masse, or to accent.	3a, full sun, prefers well drained soil. ht. 24", sp. 15"
Stella d'Oro Daylily <i>Hemerocallis 'Stella d'Oro'</i>	Well known for its golden trumpet shaped flowers, this is a great addition to a traditional style garden.	Zone 3a, Full sun or partial shade, does well in moist or dry soil, ht. 18", sp. 7"
White Delight Creeping Phlox <i>Phlox subulata 'White Delight'</i>	Produces a blanket of green foliage that blooms in late spring. Great from slope, rocky places, or gardens.	Zone 2, Full sun, prefers well drained soil. ht. 6", sp. 18"
Pink Flame Phlox <i>Phlox paniculata 'Pink Flame Dwarf'</i>	Beautiful pink flowers tout this species of Phlox. It is mildew resistant, and a wonderful choice for traditional style landscapes.	Zone 3a, Full sun or partial shade, does well in moist or dry soil, ht. 18", sp. 18"
Emerald Blue Creeping Phlox <i>Phlox subulata 'Emerald Blue'</i>	A dense herbaceous evergreen perennials with lavender star shaped flowers. Great from slope, rocky places, or gardens.	Zone 2a, Full sun to partial shade, prefers well drained soil. ht. 6", sp. 18"

Dragons Blood StoneCrop <i>Sedum spurium 'Dragon's Blood'</i>	Vigorous succulent groundcover plant, with red/pink flowers. Adds visual interest	Zone 2a, Full sun to partial shade, prefers well drained soil. ht. 4", sp. 18"
Angelina StoneCrop <i>Sedum rupestre 'Angelina'</i>	A unique succulent, to accent a traditional or xeriscape garden.	Zone 2a, Full sun to partial shade, prefers well drained soil. ht. 8", sp. 10"
FireWitch Maiden Pinks <i>Dianthus gratianopolitanus 'Firewitch'</i>	Fuschia colour flowers atop blue grass like stems. Blooms from late spring, and periodically throughout the summer.	Zone 3, Full sun, prefers moist soil, ht. 8", sp. 8"

Common Name <i>Latin/Scientific</i>	Details	Specifications
'Karl Foerster' Feather Reed <i>Calamagrostis 'Karl Foerster'</i>	Tall grass, grows quickly, and looks good in the winter.	Zone 4, full sun, well drained soil, ht. 2m
Blue Oat Grass <i>Helictotrichon sempervirens</i>	Great silvery blue colour, and mounded form. Won't spread or take over the garden.	Zone 4, full sun, well drained soil, ht. 1m
Little Bluestem <i>Schizachyrium scoparium</i>	Hardy native plant, with grey-green colour that changes to purple/red/orange in the fall.	Zone 4, full sun, well drained soil, ht. 1m
